New programs!



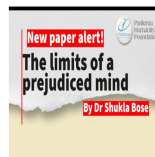
Our girls are excited and looking forward to a whole new project and a lot of learning – They have been selected to be part of the "women behind the camera project" conducted by the Rotary Club.
